University of Bath Institute for Sustainability launched

The new University of Bath Institute for Sustainability (IFS) held its inaugural event on 17 January 2023. The institute brings together multidisciplinary expertise in tackling the most pressing climate and sustainability issues facing society.

The IFS is an evolution of the Centre for Sustainable and Circular Technologies (CSCT), a research centre that has accrued many successes since its foundation in 2008. Led by leading sustainability academics Professors Matthew Davidson and Marcelle McManus, research at the Institute for Sustainability will be focused around two themes: Sustainable Chemical Technologies and Sustainable Systems.

The agreement took effect on 1 December 2022.

Three Bath researchers make Highly Cited Researcher list 2022

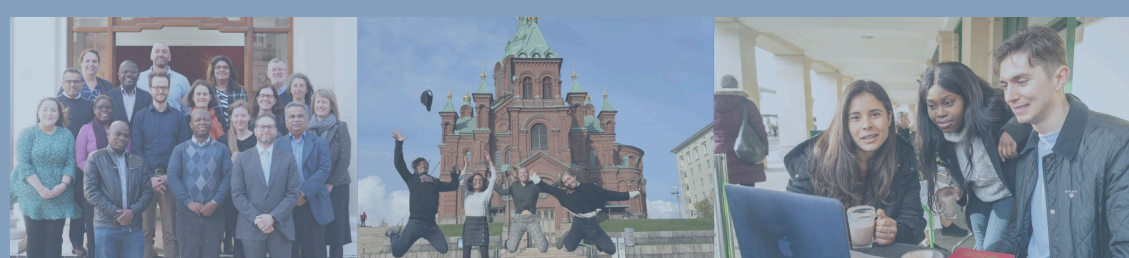
