Medals won by Bath athletes so far include:

- Gold for Kieran Bird and Tom Dean, 4x200m Freestyle relay swimming
- Bronze for Becky Wilde, Double scull rowing
- Silver for Ben Proud, 50m Freestyle swimming

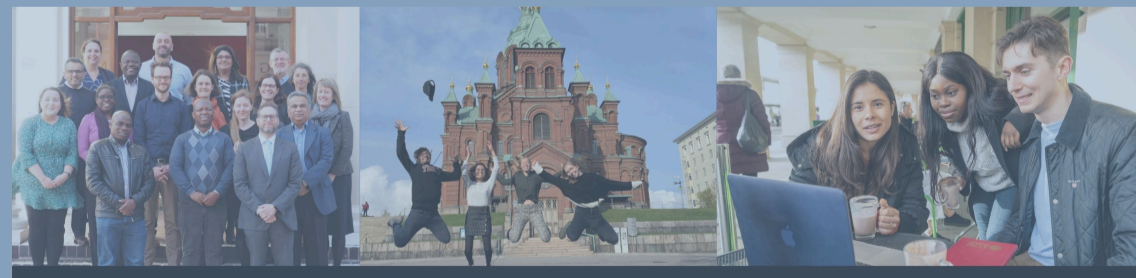
