Investor stewardship in the context of the common ownership debate

Following the financial crisis, stewardship, i.e. responsible and conscious involvement of institutional investors into the governance of companies they invest in, seemed like the right step forward. However, with the growth of passive management, asset managers are finding themselves increasingly in the 'common owner' position where they invest across listed firms within the same sector. Consequently, the question has arisen as to whether this situation can reduce competition. The debate on the coexistence of investor stewardship and common ownership is very timely and relevant, especially in the UK context, where institutional investors hold a significant fraction of publicly listed companies. Dr Anastasia Petraki, Head of Research and Statistics at the Investment Association (IA), is responsible for all IA research output and data services that are concerned with the fund market, financial stability, and investor stewardship.
