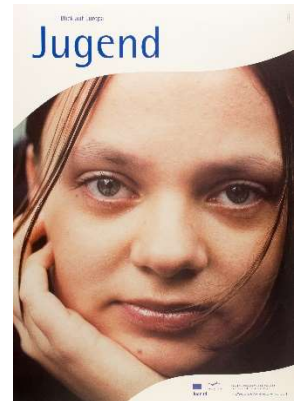
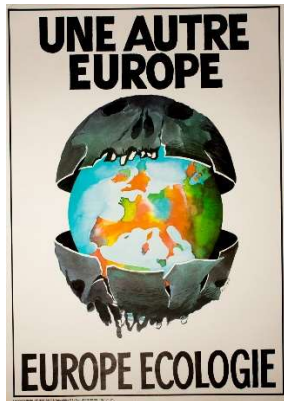

GENERAL INTRODUCTION

PROVENANCE

The posters were purchased by the Library from a private collector in 2017 with the aim of obtaining a representative sample touching on broad themes of European integration. The purchase was made possible through the support of the Department of Politics, Languages & International Studies (PoLIS) and the Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences. From the outset it was intended that the Collection would be used as a teaching and research resource for academic staff and students.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

The Collection comprises 162 posters, of various sizes, with a small amount of accompanying printed ephemera. The posters range in date from 1997 to 2015, with one earlier poster from 1972. Most of the posters were created by the European Union (EU) or one of its administrative departments (Directorates General), but some were created by organisations and movements outside the EU.

Selected to give an overview, the posters feature the languages of most European countries, but focus mainly on French, German, Dutch and English. They cover a wide range of political and social issues in a European context, from the environment and immigration to consumer rights and freedom of speech, documenting the visual communication of information, ideas and agenda to audiences across the continent.

The posters, used to convey complex, sometimes fairly abstract, messages to large groups of people, provide a colourful snapshot of a particular moment in European history. As part of an evolving European culture, they present views of a common identity while also evidencing the continuing individuality of European Union member states.
